SPRAY DRIFT RESTRAINTS

DO NOT allow bystanders to come into contact with the spray cloud.

Use the shorter interval during periods of wet weather, or in areas with past histories of the disease. Thoroughly spray pineapple foliage and surrounding soil. For the first treatment, hand drenching is preferred to spraying. Use 2000L/ha for young plants, increasing up to 5000L/ha for large plants. Imtrade Metalaxyl 250 EC Systemic Fungicide should be applied in alternate years only. In intervening year, use other recommended fungicides.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Mixing

Pour Imtrade Metalaxyl 250 EC Fungicide directly into water in the spray tank and mix well. Beware of solvent vapours while handling the concentrate and working near an open spray tank.

Some naturally occurring individual fungi resistant to Imtrade Metalaxyl 250 EC Fungicide and other Group 4 Fungicides may exist through normal genetic variability in any fungal population. The resistant individuals can eventually dominate the fungal population if Imtrade Metalaxyl 250 EC Fungicide and other Group 4 Fungicides are used repeatedly. These resistant fungi will not be controlled by Imtrade Metalaxyl 250 EC Fungicide and other Group 4 Fungicides, thus resulting in a reduction in efficacy and possible yield loss.
